NEARLY 80% of people with hearing loss live in low-income and middle-income countries

Ear and hearing care interventions are cost-effective

Hearing loss is expensive to communities and costs the region US\$ 27 billion annually



Over a 10-year period, this promises a return of nearly US\$ 2 for every US dollar invested
